Held in central Canberra, the event will feature guest speaker Brenda Mathews, a proud Wiradjuri woman and author and co-director of "The Last Daughter."

There will also be an in person foster care panel at 6pm at the Bruce office. Some of our existing foster carers will be present on the day to help answer your questions and share their first-hand experience of being a Carer with ACT Together. This Carer Panel will give you and other members of your family an opportunity to learn more about foster care in the ACT and ask any questions you may have to some of our existing foster carers.
